## Counting Grid Game Assembly Instructions

- 1. Cut out the maple leaf grid markers. You can also use items from around your house as grid markers. Buttons, coins, even cheerios would do.
- 2. Assemble the printable die included in this week's activity pack. If you already have a plastic die around your house that will work too.
- 3. Once all your pieces are assembled, you're ready to play.

## How to Play

- 1. Roll the game die.
- 2. Identify the number on the die and count out that many grid markers.
- 3. Place one grid marker over each square on the game board.
- 4. Keep rolling the die and placing your markers until the game board is full.


