Materials:

- Pokemon colouring pages
- Crayons
- Paper plates (2, one needs to be cut in half)
- Red construction paper
- Black construction paper
- White paper
- Tape
- Hole punch
- Scissors
- Fastening brads

How to Make it:

Step One: Colour and cut out your Pokemon of choice. Tape it in the centre of your full paper plate.

Step Two: Line the red paper up with one of the cut plate halves, and using the plate as a sizing guide, cut a semi-circle out of the red paper that is the size of the plate half, then tape it to the back of the plate half.

Step Three: Cut a 1" strip of black paper that is the width of the plate diameter, then tape it on the bottom/cut edge of the red semi-circle.

Step Four: Cut a black circle, and a slightly smaller white circle. Tape the white circle on top of the black circle, then tape the combined piece to the center of the black paper strip.

Step Five: Using a hole punch, punch holes in the left side of the full plate (the one with the Pokémon on it), in the left corner of the plate half with the red and black paper attached, and the left corner of the other plate half (with the back of the plate facing up).

Step Six: Use a fastening brad to secure all pieces together. The plate half with the red and black paper attached should be the top layer, then the second plate half, with the full plate being the bottom layer.
