- b. **Fundraising Plan and Consultant**: the board discussed the proposal provided by KEACanada (Kathy Arney, President and Founder), which includes a needs investigation and contracted support that includes facilitating a Board retreat and building a strategic plan and communications strategy. Alex moved to approve signing the proposal and contract KEACanada for these services. Carried

6. New Business

a. **Recruitment:** Board needs to replace one board position. Recruitment will take place in the fall (September). Board members are encouraged to think about

friends and colleagues who may be interested in sitting on the Board. Sarah is working on the Town of Banff recruitment questionnaire.

b. **LS 5 Hours of Service Policy:** BD&P Committee reviewed and updated the Policy. Monica moved to accept the policy as presented, including list of statutory holidays. Motion carried.

7. Reports

- a. HR&F (Human Resources and Finance) Committee: only Sarah and Ali were able to attend the May Committee meeting. They discussed setting up the annual performance evaluation for Sarah McCormack and reviewing/updating the Library Director contract. Manuela is working on the contract and Liz will review. A vote for Chair of the Committee did not take place because the other committee members were absent.
- b. **BD&P** (Board Development and Policy) Committee: the BD&P meeting notes from May 23, 2023 were posted to Teams.

Meet the Board Day: The committee discussed changing "Meet the Board Day" into an opportunity for Board members to take turns representing BPL during the weekly Farmer's Market in Banff. We can share a table with Town of Banff. Sarah will share a schedule with the Board so that directors can volunteer for specific days. Sarah can get name tags for Board members.

<u>Marigold Conference</u>: Monica reported that 4 Board members attended and it was a great learning experience. Sarah encouraged each Board member to submit a report about what they learned.

<u>Committee Chair and Meetings</u>: Candice Noakes offered to take over as Chair. All in favour. The next meetings will take place on June 23, July 25 and August 24 at 5 pm. Kaylee extended her regrets for the July and August meetings.

They have a great Library of Things as well as spaces that can be borrowed such as an entrepreneur room, interview room, and sewing room. They also have a library on wheels.

Kaylee reported that she discussed the issues of the cracked uneven pavement outside the entrance way and the falling lights with the Town of Banff and they are actioning repairs.
