

Counting Grid Game Assembly Instructions

1. Cut out the maple leaf grid markers. You can also use items from around your house as grid markers. Buttons, coins, even cheerios would do.
2. Assemble the printable die included in this week's activity pack. If you already have a plastic die around your house that will work too.
3. Once all your pieces are assembled, you're ready to play.

How to Play

1. Roll the game die.
2. Identify the number on the die and count out that many grid markers.
3. Place one grid marker over each square on the game board.
4. Keep rolling the die and placing your markers until the game board is full.

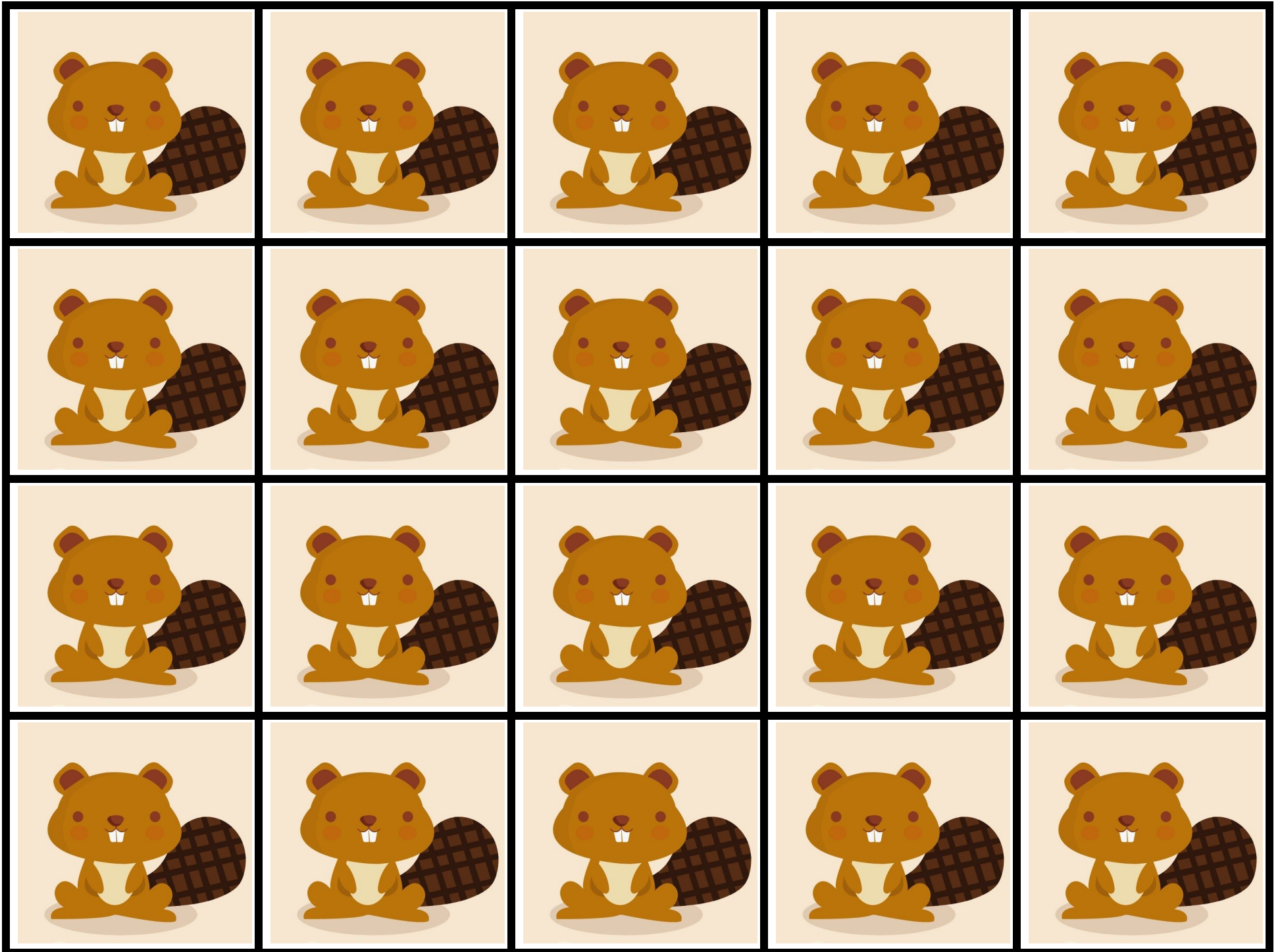

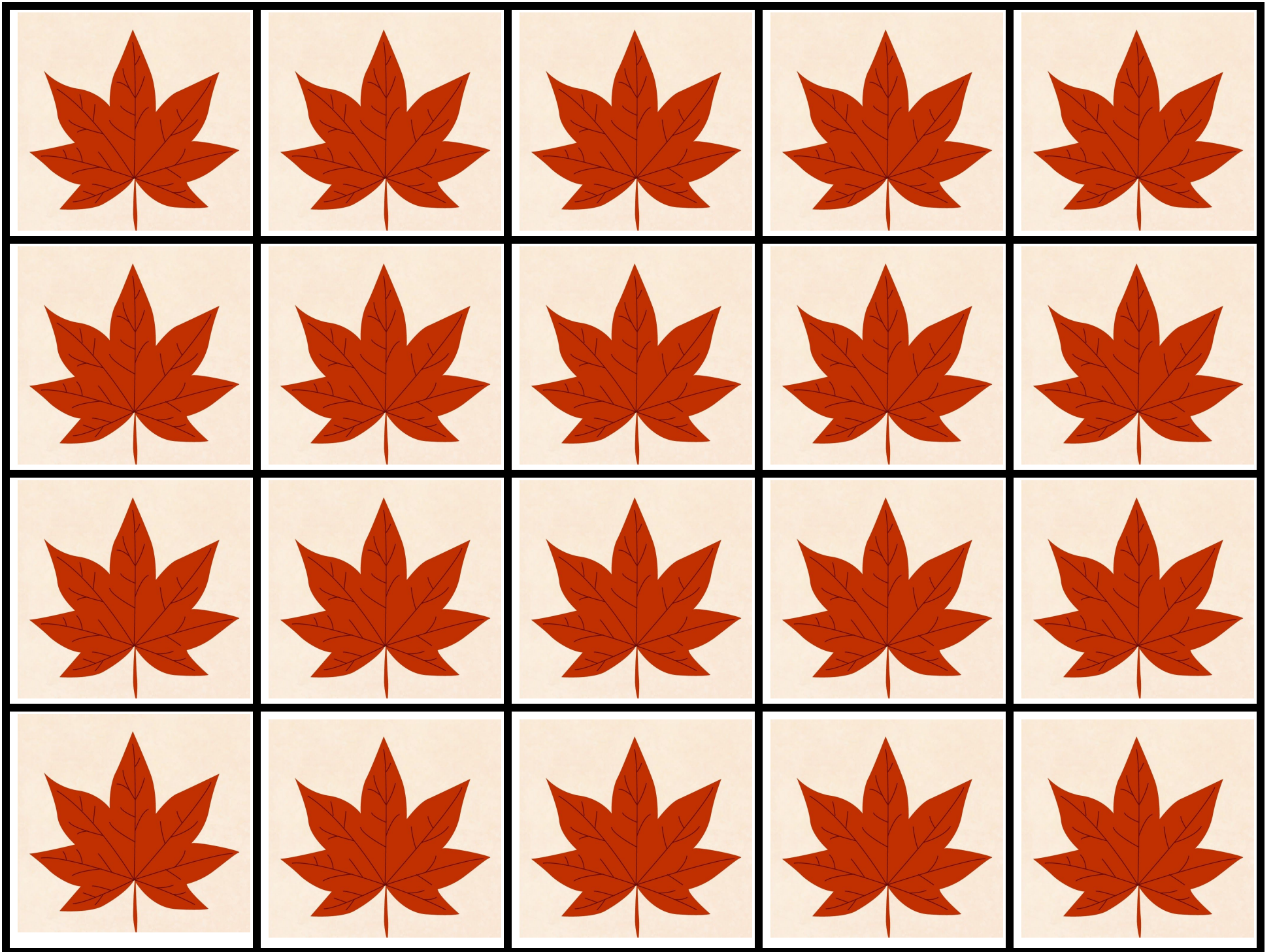

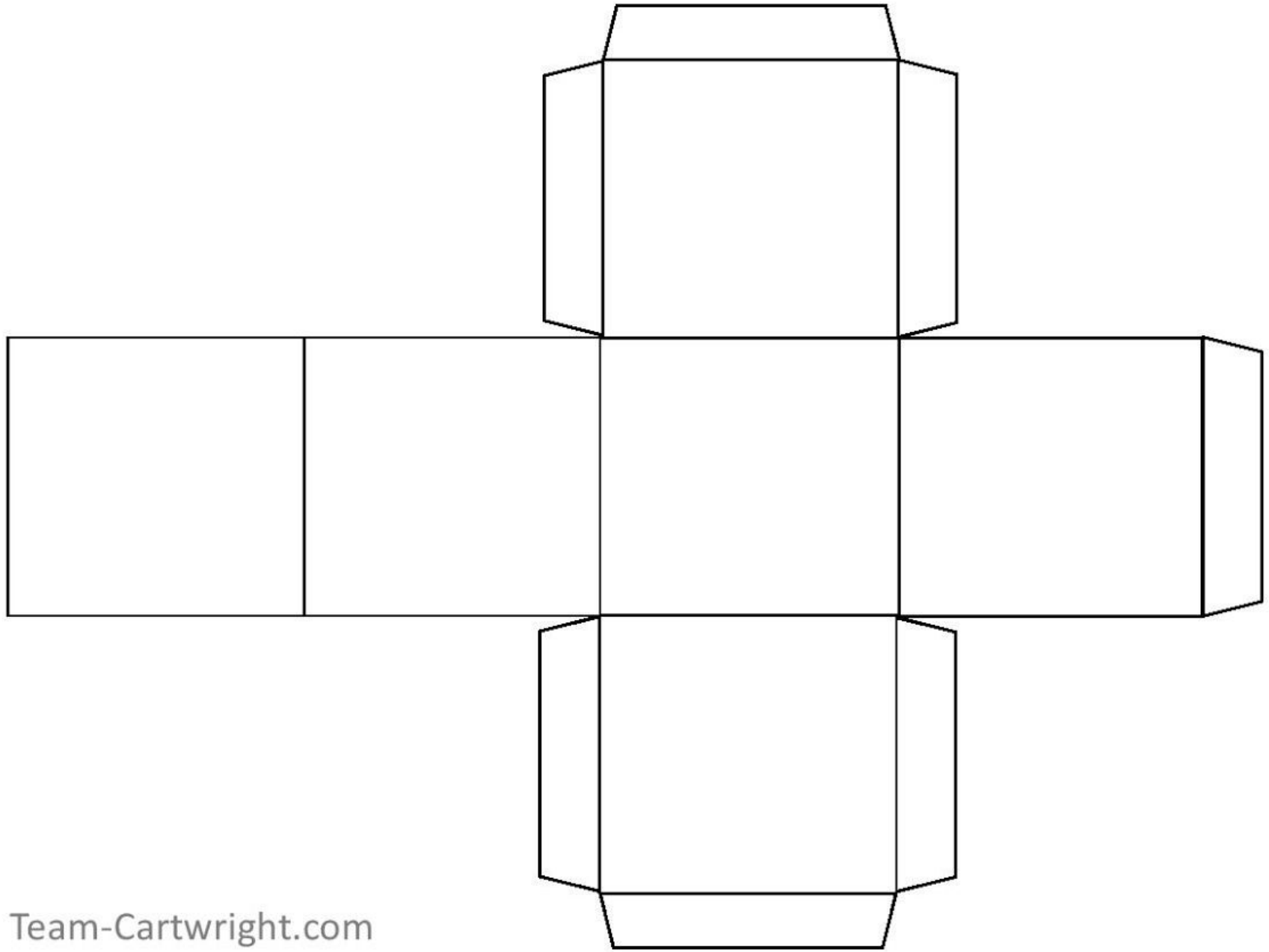
