Hopscotch



- Draw a hopscotch diagram on the ground outside with chalk.
- Number the squares from 1 to 10.
- Pick a small stone or twig to use as a marker.
- Throw your marker onto the diagram, aiming for one of the squares.
- Hop on one foot into the first empty square, and then every subsequent empty square. Be sure to jump over the square that your marker is on.
- Whenever you reach a pair of squares that are side by side, jump on them with both feet.
- At the last square, jump with both feet, turn around, and head back toward the start.
- When you reach the square your marker is on, pick up the marker—still on one foot!—and complete the course.

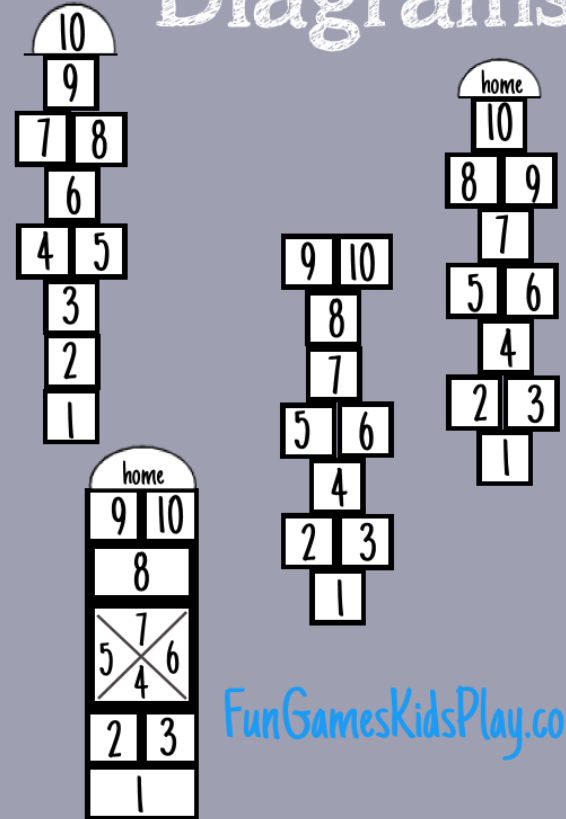
