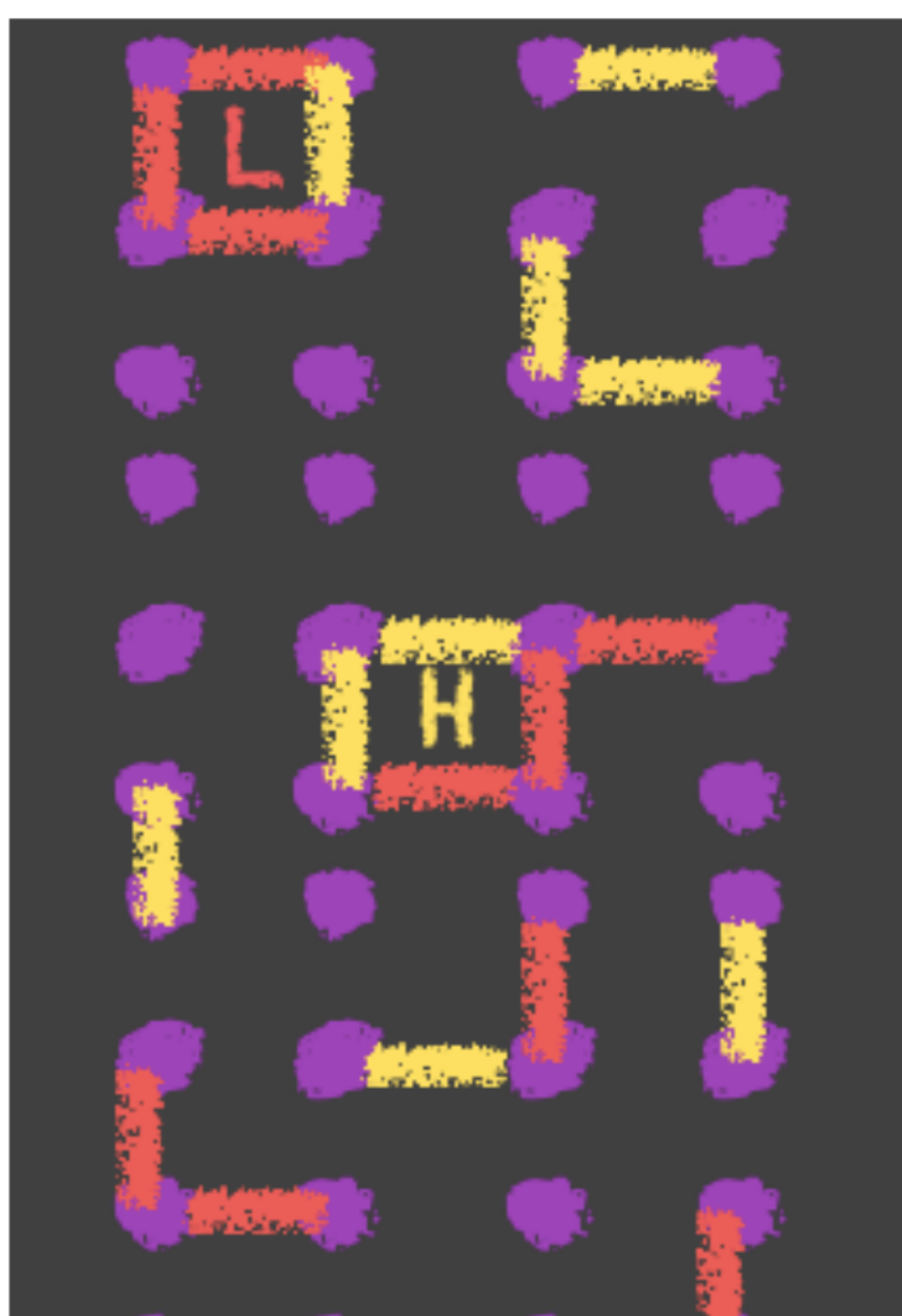


Summer Reading Retro Game: Dots and Lines



- Select a few different colours of chalk. A bold one for the game board and one for each player.
- Create a grid of dots an equal distance apart, as big as you'd like.
- Each player takes a turn connecting two dots either vertically or horizontally.
- When a player's turn closes a box, they can colour it in, write their initial or even draw a shape.
- Continue like this until the entire board is filled with boxes. Then tally up the amount of boxes each player has. The player with the most boxes is the winner.
