

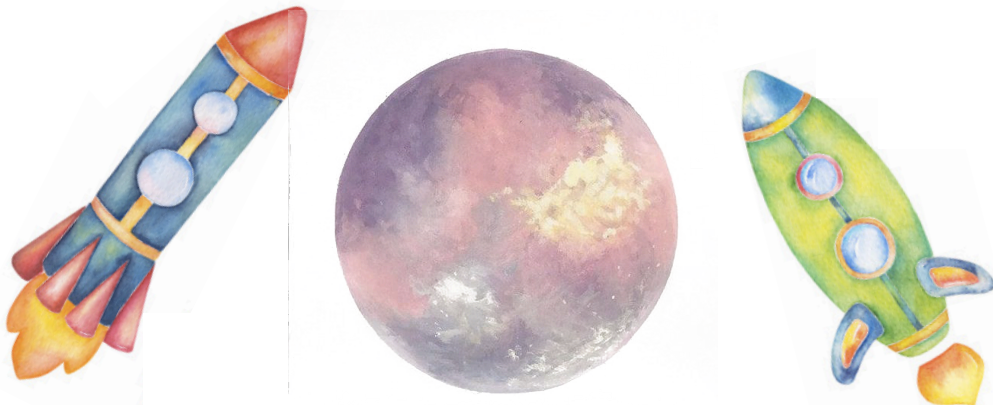
Eyedropper Planet Painting!

Materials:

- Coffee filters
- Food colouring (as many colours as you'd like)
- Pen
- Scissors
- An eyedropper tool (a paint brush will work fine if you don't have an eyedropper on hand.)

How to do it:

1. Mix a few drops of food colouring into a small container of water. (The more drops of colour you use, the better the colour will show up on the coffee filter.)
2. Draw 1-3 circles on you coffee filter(s).
3. Layer a few pieces of paper towel beneath your work space for the next steps.
4. Use the eyedropper tool or a paintbrush to add colours to each circle.
5. Let the filters dry completely.
6. Cut each planet out.
7. Hang individually or together (by glueing each planet to sheet of paper) to display.
