

How to Make 3D Planets!

Materials:

- Coloured construction paper.
- Scissors
- Pencil
- String
- Circular objects (to trace circles)
- Glue
- Hole Punch

How to do it:

1. Trace circular objects on your paper. Cans or food containers are great! Cut out circles.
2. Fold one circle in half.
3. Cut a slit down the center of the circle stopping short of the edge by about 1/4".
4. Cut slits in additional circles.
5. Take an uncut circle and begin sliding the slit circles onto it.
6. Continue adding slit circles until you get the shape you want. If you cut different sizes of circles you can layer them on the main disc.
7. Add a little glue if you want at the connection points to secure everything in place.
8. Punch a hole in the top of the main disc.
9. Thread your string through the hole and hang.
